## Findings show that there is lack of knowledge, for example:

High School students in Greece and Italy seem to have low/moderate level of content knowledge on issues pertaining to oceans and the Mediterranean Sea

(Mediterranean Marine Science, Special Issue Ocean Literacy, 2022)

European adults show moderate concern for the marine environment and have significant knowledge gaps on marine related issues

(CLAMER survey, KnowSeas Project)

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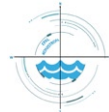
